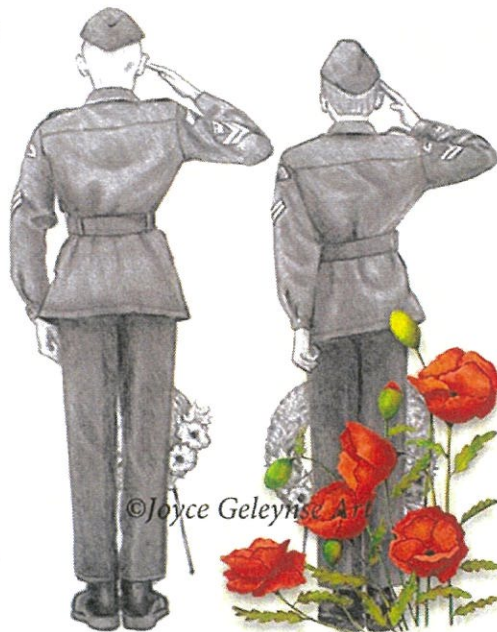
In Flanders Fields
