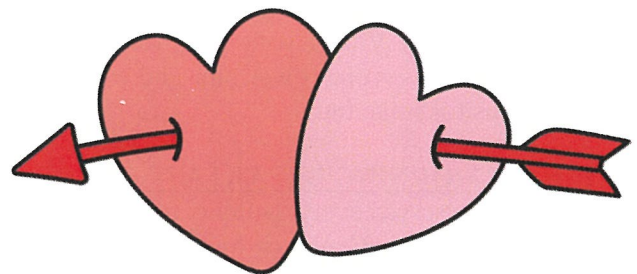


### **Congratulations to Merle Burlet on winning this years Chili Cookoff!**
