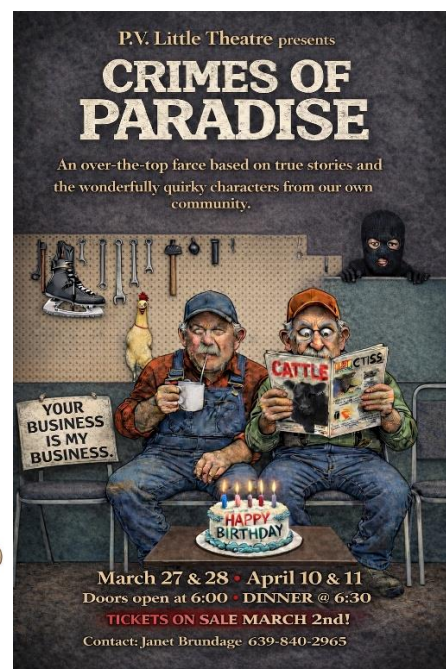
SATURDAY MORNING BREAKFAST
